## **Classes and Objects**

## **Concepts:**

- Class → Acts as a blueprint for creating objects (like a template).
- Object → An instance of a class that allows access to the data and functions inside the class.
- **Self** → Connects the object to the class, allowing access to variables and methods.

## Simple Example:

```
1. Without Function:

Class a:

Name = "hello"

Z = a()
```

2. With Function:

Print(z.name)

```
Class a:

Name = "hello"

Def abc(self):

Print(self.name)
```

```
Z = a()
Z,name = " Hello"
Print(z.name)
```
